



# HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION PROGRAM

## What is Homelessness Prevention?

Homelessness Prevention provides individuals and families who are **at imminent risk of homelessness** with:

- Financial assistance and housing stabilization services necessary to maintain their current housing; OR
- Find new housing to avoid becoming homeless and entering the emergency shelter system.

## Who is eligible for the Homelessness Prevention Program?

- Homelessness Prevention may be available to persons who are currently residing within Los Angeles County, screened as having a high risk of becoming homeless **AND** meet at least one of the following criteria:
  - ✓ Experiencing a financial crisis and at imminent risk of becoming homeless within 30 days.
  - ✓ Have received written notice of intent to terminate tenancy from a landlord, property manager or lease holder.
  - ✓ Have received an Unlawful Detainer (court eviction hearing notice or court-ordered eviction).

## What are the required Income eligibility guidelines for assistance?

- Must fall below the 50% Area Median Income (AMI)
- Formerly Homeless Section 8 holders with income up to 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)
