

# HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION PROGRAM

# What is Homelessness Prevention?

Homelessness Prevention provides individuals and families who are at imminent risk of homelessness with:

- Financial assistance and housing stabilization services necessary to maintain their current housing; OR
- Find new housing to avoid becoming homeless and entering the emergency shelter system.

## Who is eligible for the Homelessness Prevention Program?

- Homelessness Prevention may be available to persons who are currently residing within Los Angeles County, screened as having a <u>high risk of becoming homeless</u> AND meet <u>at least one</u> of the following criteria:
  - Experiencing a financial crisis and at imminent risk of becoming homeless within 30 days.
  - Have received written notice of intent to terminate tenancy from a landlord, property manager or lease holder.

- Must fall below the 50% Area Median Income (AMI)
- Formerly Homeless Section 8 holders with income up to 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)
